

Results of rice area survey for 2021 (Source: Ente Nazionale Risi note)

966 rice producers responded to the Ente Nazionale Risi's area survey for 2021.

The replies represent around 26% of the hectares cultivated in 2020. Last year's survey was based on fewer replies (826) covering 23% of the previous year's area.

Overall, there was an increase of almost 2,000 hectares (+0.9%) compared to 2020 sowings, due to increases in the Long B (+5,825 hectares) and Medium/Long A (+4,910 hectares) types. On the other hand, the Round type decreased by 13% (-8,754 hectares). Click here to consult the situation in detail.







A border rejection was sent by Spain concerning aflatoxins (B1 = 3 µg/kg - ppb) in white rice from Pakistan.

A border rejection was sent by Greece concerning aflatoxins (B1 = 3.1 µg/kg - ppb) in basmati rice from Pakistan.

An information for follow-up was sent by Ireland concerning rice from Italy infested with insects.

An alert was sent by Netherlands concerning ochratoxin A (11.2 µg/kg - ppb) in organic brown basmati rice from Pakistan.




In focus

The volumes cleared through EU customs in the 2020/2021 campaign amount to 505,266 tonnes, in milled equivalent, 6% less than last year.

Paddy rice imports, amounting to 11,135 tonnes, increased by 73%, husked rice imports, amounting to 207,932 tonnes, decreased by 13%, whereas semi-milled and milled rice imports, amounting to 286,198 tonnes, decreased by 3%. Husked Basmati rice imports increased by 44,860 tonnes (+38%), from 118,288 tonnes a year ago to 163,147 tonnes today.

EU exports, amounting to 102,110 tonnes, in milled equivalent, increased by 9% compared to last campaign.


In focus

In the last week paddy rice transfers by farmers reached 32,527 tonnes: 13,746 tonnes of long A grain, 10,385 tonnes of round grain, 7,513 tonnes of long B grain and 883 tonnes of medium grain.

At Commodity Exchange in Vercelli, the paddy prices increased for Long B (+€15) and Ribe (+€10).

Up to 29 January 2021, Italian imports, amounting to 45,683 tonnes, in milled equivalent, increased by 9,079 tonnes (+25%) compared to last campaign.

Also the volumes cleared through customs increased (+11,054 tonnes, +28%), as you can see in table at the bottom. Italian exports amount to 56,938 tonnes, in milled equivalent, 12,819 tonnes (+29%) more than last year. With 18,071 tonnes, Turkey is the largest importer of Italian rice.
